2022 年僑務委員會海外青年線上營隊 招生簡介

一、活動宗旨

鼓勵海外青年來臺升學,瞭解臺灣文化及最新科技發展,特運用網路數位科技,開設元宇宙新興科技課程及線上營隊,擴大服務海外青年。

二、活動期間

- (一)本研習班共分3梯次辦理,各梯次辦理期間如下:
 - 1、第1梯次(新南向地區專班):2022年8月6日至10月9日, 共10週,每週1天,每次2小時,總時數20小時,每週六或週日上課。
 - 2、第2梯次(全球密集班):2022年8月8日至8月19日,共2週,每週5天,每天2小時,總時數20小時。
 - 3、第3梯次(全球週六及週日班):2022年8月20日至9月18日,共5週,每週2天,每次2小時,總時數20小時,每週六及週日上課。
- (二)為配合僑居地時區差異,上課時間如下:。
 - 1、第1梯次(新南向地區專班):每週六或週日臺灣時間下午3時至5時。
 - 2、第2梯次(全球密集班):

上午班:臺灣時間上午8時至10時。

下午班:臺灣時間下午3時至5時。

3、第3梯次(全球週六及週日班):

上午班:臺灣時間上午8時至10時。

下午班:臺灣時間下午3時至5時。

三、參加資格

年滿 16 足歲至未滿 25 歲(以護照所載出生年月日為憑),須具有僑

胞卡或i僑卡,年齡計算至報名參加該營隊開班日,具僑居國護照或僑居身分加簽,目前居住於海外。

四、課程內容

- (一)臺灣簡介:介紹臺灣政治、經濟、文化、教育與科技,讓學 員對臺灣有整體認識。
- (二)元宇宙概念與應用課程:提供元宇宙課程,以深入淺出的方式講解,增進對元宇宙認識。
- (三)臺灣高科技與文創特色課程:智慧應用、研發管理、物聯網、就業養成、文化資產應用及環境永續發展等。
- (四)臺語研習:介紹發音、簡單生活應用會話、臺語童謠、臺灣歌曲或其他與臺語研習相關課程。
- (五)參訪國內大學校院、產學攜手合作專班學校及海外青年技術訓 練班二年制副學士學位班學校:介紹學校教學環境、設備及校園 景觀與科系介紹。
- (六)文化參訪:介紹臺灣人文風貌、文創園區、生態環境、國家公園、古蹟、節慶民俗、或具臺灣特色名勝等,安排線上闖關遊戲,並提供獎品。
- (七)產業參訪:介紹電競產業或團體、核心戰略產業(資訊及數位產業、資安卓越產業、臺灣精準健康產業、國防及戰略產業、綠能及再生能源產業、民生及戰備產業)及具臺灣特色之高科技產業,安排線上闖關遊戲,並提供獎品。
- (八)成果發表會:舉辦貼文比賽,撰寫貼文(圖片、影片或文字),於個人臉書(Facebook)、Instagram、Pinterest 分享線上營隊文化參訪與企業參訪之心得。

五、報名程序

(一)報名及期限:各梯次自即日起開始受理報名,至開班前2週或當期人數額滿即截止。

(二)報名方式:請填具報名表並檢附照片1張及護照基本資料頁影本, 透過郵寄、電子郵件或就近至中華民國政府駐外單位,或海外文教 服務中心報名;未經前開單位核轉者,概不受理(國內報名恕不受 理)。

六、注意事項

- (一)本營隊費用由僑務委員會全額負擔。
- (二)學員須自備電腦、網路、耳機、麥克風及攝像鏡頭等。
- (三)研習期間必須遵守各項規定,如有重大違規情事,僑務委員會得依規定予以退班。
- (四)學員同步課程出席時數至少達總時數 80%(不含始業式與結業式), 且學習評量及格者,本會將寄發中英文結業證書電子檔,並由承辦 單位傳送結業成績予及格學員。

Admission Guidelines of the 2022 Online Camp for Overseas Compatriot Youth

1. Objective

The Overseas Community Affairs Council, ROC (Taiwan) (OCAC) will use internet technology to hold metaverse new technology courses and an Online Camp to encourage overseas compatriot youth to come to Taiwan for further education and help them understand Taiwan's culture and latest technology developments.

2. Program schedule

- (1) The program is divided into 3 different sessions. The date for each session is as follows:
 - a. 1st session (New Southbound Region Special Class): August 6th to October 9th, 2022, (10 weeks, 1 day per week, 2 hours per day, 20 hours per session), every Saturday or Sunday.
 - b. 2nd session (Global Intensive Class): August 8th to August 19th, 2022, (2 weeks, 5 days per week, 2 hours per day, 20 hours per session).
 - c. 3rd session (Global Saturday and Sunday Class): August 20th to September 18th, 2022, (5 weeks, 2 days per week, 2 hours per day, 20 hours per session), every Saturday and Sunday.
- (2) To adapt to different time zones, class times are as follows:
 - a. Session 1

3 pm to 5 pm Taiwan time (GMT+8) every Saturday or Sunday.

b. Session 2:

Morning class: 8 am to 10 am Taiwan time (GMT+8).

Afternoon class: 3 pm to 5 pm Taiwan time (GMT+8)

c. Session 3:

Morning class: 8 am to 10 am Taiwan time (GMT+8).

Afternoon class: 3 pm to 5 pm Taiwan time (GMT+8)

3. Eligibility

Anyone aged over 16 and under 25 years of age (based on birth date in passport), who holds an Overseas Compatriot Card or i-Compatriot Card and passport issued by his or her country of residence or Taiwan passport with Overseas Compatriot Identity Endorsement, and currently resides overseas.

4. Course contents

- (1) Introduction to Taiwan: Introduce Taiwan's politics, economy, culture, education and technology to give participants an overall understanding of Taiwan.
- (2) Metaverse concept and application courses: Provide metaverse courses, presented in an easy-to-understand way, to increase student understanding of the metaverse.
- (3) Taiwan high-tech and cultural and creative distinctive courses: Smart application, R&D management, IoT, employment nurturing, cultural property application and environmental sustainable development.
- (4) Taiwanese language study: Pronunciation, simple conversation for daily life, Taiwanese nursery rhymes, Taiwanese songs, and other Taiwanese study related courses.
- (5) Visits to domestic universities, industry-academia cooperation special class schools and the Overseas Compatriot Youth Vocational Training Program schools: Introduce the school teaching environment, equipment, campus scenery and departments.
- (6) Cultural visits: Taiwan's cultural landscape, cultural and creative parks, national parks, folk festivals, and scenic spots will be introduced and online challenge games with prizes arranged.
- (7) Industry visits: The e-gaming industry and groups, core strategic

industries (information and digital industries, cyber security industry, precision medicine industry, defense and strategic industries, green energy and renewable energy industries, strategic stockpile industries) and distinctive Taiwan high-tech industries will be introduced. Online challenge games will also be arranged with prizes to be won.

(8) Achievement presentation: Hold a social media contest post competition (photos, videos or text,) with students posting about their cultural and enterprise visits during the program on their personal Facebook, Instagram, Pinterest page.

5. Application Procedures

- (1) Registration date: from now until 2 weeks before each session starts or each session is full.
- (2) Registration method: please fill in the registration form and attach an ID photo and a copy of your passport basic information page. Please apply by mail or e-mail, or through the nearest overseas representative office of the ROC or Culture Center of a Taipei Economic and Cultural Office. Applications that are not transferred by the above offices will not be accepted. (No domestic applications will be accepted).

6. Important Notices

- (1) The fee for this program will be subsided by the OCAC.
- (2) Students should prepare a computer, internet, headset, microphone, and webcam.
- (3) During the program, students must abide by the regulations. If there are major violations, the OCAC may expel students from the program according to the regulations.
- (4) Students are required to attend at least 80% of hours of simultaneous classes (excluding the opening and closing ceremonies) and pass study

evaluation. The OCAC will send an electronic Certificate of Completion in Chinese and in English and the undertaking unit will send completion results to students who pass the program.
