I. Introduction of Program

About IMBA

The International MBA is the premier English Taught business program offered by National Chengchi University's College of Commerce.

We are the first and only such program in Taiwan to offer a fully accredited Masters of Business Administration completely in English.

We offer all course instruction in English with a specific focus on Asia-Pacific business dynamics, and cross-cultural understanding. Half of the students and faculty are local Taiwan citizens and the latter half are from abroad, representing a diverse mixture of people from more than 20 countries on 5 continents.

The program is slated for 2 years of instruction (Maximum 5 years to fulfill program requirements) and requires a minimum of 42 credit hours for completion. The students will earn the “International Master of Business Administration” degree from College of Commerce.

Thank you for your interest in the International MBA (IMBA) Program. This package provides you with all of the information and materials necessary to complete the application for admission. Please read the instructions carefully before completing the application.

ADMISSIONS POLICY AND CRITERIA

The mission of the International MBA Program is to train and develop qualified candidates to be leaders in the field of international business, with a special focus on the Asia-Pacific region. Our assessment is designed to identify individuals we believe will make contributions to the leadership of international business. Applicants are encouraged to submit any documentation that they feel will allow the Admissions Committee to better understand their record of accomplishments and leadership capabilities.

ADMISSIONS SCHEDULE

Local Applicants (Taiwan-ROC Nationals)

Local applicants are required to submit an online application form between December 24th, 2009 and December 30th, 2009. Please print out and submit all hard-copy application package materials to the University admissions office before December 31st, 2009. Please check both websites for detailed information including the application package schedule and additional university application documents.

International Applicants (Without Taiwan-ROC Citizenship)

The tentative schedule for international applicants is that application packages will be accepted beginning February 22nd, 2010 and end April 15th, 2010, please visit IMBA website for updates. Particularly students seeking merit-based financial aid consideration please check our website (<http://imba.nccu.edu.tw/admissions/scholarships.php>) for availability and details.

Important Notes for International Applicants:

An International Applicant should not hold citizenship of the ROC. Individuals who held ROC citizenship within the past eight years will not be considered as an International Applicant and need to apply as a Local Applicant.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Minimum of 2 years of full-time post-baccalaureate work experience
2. Completion of or the equivalent of a 4-year bachelor's degree
3. Satisfactory undergraduate academic achievement
4. Competitive GMAT scores preferable
5. TOEFL score or other evidence of English proficiency for international and local applicants whose native language is not English
6. Any other materials that will help the Admissions Committee assess the applicant's potential

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

1. Personal Data Form. This form must be fully completed and signed to process your application in a timely manner. *Please typewrite or use a word processor.* Attach additional pages if you need more space. Your full name should appear at the top of all supporting materials. Once this form is submitted, be sure that you notify the IMBA Program, NCCU of any change of address.

In the *Employment History* area, include descriptions of your 3 most recent full-time positions, significant part-time employment, internships, or volunteer work. *Note:* Do not leave this section blank or refer to your resume.

The required *Essays* allow the Admissions Committee to learn about you, your accomplishments and your professional aspirations. Your essay should not be written or edited by anyone other than yourself. Please prepare these essays carefully and candidly, follow the instructions on the Personal Data Form.

2. Transcripts. We require one original copy of your college transcript and one copy of the diploma or other documentation indicating the date and conferral of your degree. Transcripts of additional courses that you have taken (e.g. university extension courses or post-graduate courses) are also welcome. These transcripts must be sealed in an envelope with the school registrar's signature across the seal.

While we prefer to have your transcripts enclosed in the application package, some schools will not release official transcripts directly to the applicant. Direct those institutions to send the transcripts to: IMBA Program, National Chengchi University, 64 Zhih-Nan Road Sec.2, Taipei 116, Taiwan.

If the original language of the academic record and diploma is not English or Chinese, a certified English translation must accompany original documents. Official copies of credentials must be certified by a school administrative officer from whom the degree was received.

3. Evidence of English Proficiency. We prefer the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) taken within two years as evidence of English proficiency for all international applicants who do not hold a degree from an English-speaking institution.

National Chengchi University's TOEFL code is 9993. Include a photocopy of the score report in your application package. For more information or to request that your scores be sent to us, contact TOEFL/TSE Services, PO Box 6151, Princeton, NJ 08541-6151, or visit the TOEFL web site at <http://www.toefl.org>

If you do not have a TOEFL score, you must submit other evidence of English proficiency (i.e. other test scores, history of taking English courses, etc.).

4. Evidence of Management Study Aptitude. The Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) is not a requirement for admittance to the program. Applicants are however strongly advised to take the test and submit their scores as additional support to their application. GMAT is administered by the Educational Testing Service (ETS) in the USA as evidence of management aptitude. The GMAT must be taken within five years, and can be forwarded through National Chengchi University's GMAT code 9993. Include a photocopy of the score report in your application package. For more information or to request that your scores be sent to us, contact the GMAT, Educational Testing Service, P.O. Box 6103, Princeton, NJ 08541-6103, USA, or visit the GMAT web site at <http://www.gmac.com>

Please allow 3-4 weeks for our office to receive your scores from ETS.

5. Letters of Recommendation. Three recommendations are required and should be completed by individuals who are well acquainted with you and your managerial capabilities. Preferably, they should be completed by employers or supervisors. You are advised to request recommendations well in advance of the application deadline to ensure your application package is complete when submitted.

6. Financial Aid. Financial aid is available through the IMBA program in the form of merit-based scholarships. We offer a variety of scholarships to students demonstrating academic merit and leadership potential. If you are interested in applying for a scholarship, please go to our website (<http://imba.nccu.edu.tw>) for details and forms. You must complete and submit any

scholarship applications along with this admissions application form to be considered for a scholarship. Upon receipt of your admission form and scholarship application, the committee will review your application and make a judgment.

7. **Financial Solvency:** For international students only. Applicants need to submit proof of their financial solvency by obtaining a statement or certificate from their bank. Unless the document is issued by a Taiwanese bank, it should be verified by the Taiwan Overseas Mission in (or nearest to) the country of the bank.

8. **Proof of Nationality (ex. Passport):** For international applicants only.

9. **Address Label:** For international applicants only.


