



- Registration Method: If interested in registering, before, please submit your completed application form by e-mail to hu0969@gov.taipei / supervisor: Ms. KAO / tel: +886-2-27208889ext.1562
- Promotional Booth: Participants displaying lanterns may apply for a promotional booth; however, please handle set-up on your own, and arrange personnel to staff the booth during the full lantern display period.
- Publicity Materials: After confirmation of display participation, please assist by providing relevant graphics and other promotional materials, lantern design drawings, etc. Notification of submission deadlines and specifications will be provided separately at a later date.
- Due to venue space limitations, if application interest is heavy, priority will be given to organizations in the order in which display applications have been submitted.
