



2026 Mandarin Summer Camp

Chinese Language Education Center (CLEC) of the National Taipei University of Education will organize and hold the Mandarin Camp in 2026. The program will provide youth and children with the opportunity to learn Mandarin and experience Taiwanese culture through all kinds of teaching activities during the camp.

I. COURSE PLAN

- (1) Applicant: Overseas students aged 6–15 who are interested in learning Mandarin (class placement based on age and proficiency; subject to enrollment numbers).
- (2) Location: National Taipei University of Education.
(Accommodation is not provided. Upon request, information on quality hotels nearby can be provided.)
- (3) Class Size: 8–12 students per class, with a maximum of 15.
- (4) Course Dates:
 - Session 1: June 22, 2026 (Mon) – July 10, 2026 (Fri)
 - Session 2: July 20, 2026 (Mon) – August 7, 2026 (Fri)
- (5) Class Hours: Monday to Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.
- (6) Registration Period: From now until all spots are filled.

IV. DISCOUNT PLAN

*Each participant may use only one discount plan, and must complete the registration process and payment within the designated period to be eligible for the discount.

*Those who register and pay after the deadline will automatically lose their eligibility. The Center will not issue additional notifications. If you wish to register afterward, please email us first to check for available spots. Do not make any payment on your own.

*For the group discount, all group members must be confirmed before making the registration payment. No additional participants may be added after payment is completed.

Plan A – Early-Bird Discount (Registration fee included):

- For those who complete registration before February 28, 2026, the fee is US\$1,490 / NT\$43,000 per person.

Plan B – Returning Student Discount (Registration fee included):

- Participants who have previously joined our summer/winter camp may register for US\$1,490 / NT\$43,000 per person.

Plan C – Returning Student Referral Discount (Registration fee included):

- When a returning student successfully refers a new student who completes registration, the new student receives a NT\$1,000 discount, paying US\$1,595 / NT\$46,000 per person.

Plan D – Group Discount

(All members must register and make payment at the same time; registration fee included)

- 2 participants: US\$1,560 / NT\$45,000 per person
- 3 participants: US\$1,525 / NT\$44,000 per person
- 4 participants: US\$1,490 / NT\$43,000 per person
- 5 participants: US\$1,455 / NT\$42,000 per person
- 6 or more participants: US\$1,420 / NT\$41,000 per person

VI. IMPORTANT NOTES

1. All times in this document are based on Taiwan's time.
2. Please read the Registration and Payment Instructions and Agreement carefully before applying. Submission of the registration form indicates full acceptance of all terms stated in the agreement.
3. Upon receiving the admission confirmation email, payment must be completed within 7 business days. Late payments will result in automatic cancellation of the registration. The Center will not issue additional notifications. If you wish to register afterward, please email us first to check for available spots; do not make any payment on your own.
4. Please choose either USD or NTD to make the payment. The difference in exchange rates will not be refunded.
5. For those paying by bank transfer, please indicate the participant's name in the remittance note. After remitting, please email ntuecleccamp@gmail.com with the participant's name, transfer time, bank name, and the last five digits of the remitting account number. A confirmation email will be sent within 7–10 business days after payment is verified.
6. Refund policy:
 - a. Apply before the program opening day, and 90% of the fee will be refunded. The registration fee will not be refunded.
 - b. Apply within the first 1/3 of camp days, and 50% of the fee will be refunded. The registration fee will not be refunded.
 - c. No refunds will be made if the application time has passed 1/3 of the camp days.
 - d. All refunds will be paid via bank transfer. Processing time is around one month.
7. Participants who show symptoms of fever or respiratory illness must wear a mask throughout the program. Absences due to illness will not be eligible for make-up classes or refunds.
8. During the camp session, if there is a typhoon, earthquake, or other unavoidable natural causes, and the Taipei municipal government has announced that classes will be canceled that day, all activities and classes for winter camp will automatically be canceled. There will be no make-up classes or refunds for the canceled classes.
