Instructions for passengers before arriving in Taiwan and clearance at the airport



Requirements to be prepared—



- ✓ A personal mobile phone with access to internet
- ✓ A reservation confirmation of quarantine hotel or following one-person-per-residence requirement
- √ Passengers tested positive for COVID-19 abroad must defer their flights to Taiwan for > 7 days from the specimen collection date to prevent cross-border transmission of the disease.

Effective from August 15, 2022, all passengers are not required to provide a negative PCR test report issued within 2 days prior to scheduled flight time.





Precautions:


- Do not eat or drink for 1 hour before sample collection.
- Spit 1-2 ml of saliva into the specimen tube.

- Picked up by friends, relatives, companies, or organizations
- ✓ Drive yourself





National Health Insurance Express App

The health authority will contact you proactively if your saliva PCR test is positive. Those who test negative will not receive any notification.

- Receive care in your quarantine site if you chose one-person-per-residence program.
- Be transferred to an enhanced quarantine hotel, a government quarantine facility, or a hospital if you chose quarantine hotel program.
 R.O.C. nationals and foreign nationals enrolled in

R.O.C. nationals and foreign nationals enrolled in the National Health Insurance (NHI) program may check the results of the saliva PCR test through the **NHI Express App**.

According to Article 58 of Communicable Disease Control Act, travelers must carefully and accurately fill out the forms and present required documents. Any traveler who refuses, evades or obstructs such measures, or provides inaccurate information shall be fined up to NT\$150,000 and may bear criminal liability.
