








Go Circular With Taiwan

Dives into Key Themes Driving Circular System Changes

The forum opens with a high-level international dialogue exploring how governments are shaping national circular economy strategies—framed by global trends and grounded in the realities of the Asia-Pacific region.

Taiwan's draft Circular Economy Roadmap will be featured as a key case study in regional policy development. Building on insights from the previous day's site visits, participants will engage in immersive showcases across six key sectors. These sessions demonstrate how industry and government leaders are transforming global challenges into actionable circular solutions on the ground.

Complementing the sectoral showcases are five thematic discussions focused on Policy & Governance, Financial Enablers, Business Transformation, Trade & Traceability, and Consumer Engagement. Designed to address system-level change, these sessions offer strategic insights for advancing circular practices across value chains and industries.
