

2022年僑務委員會海外青年語文研習班（遠距視訊教學）

全球週末班

招生簡介

一、活動宗旨

增進海外青年華語文聽、說、讀、寫及中文電腦輸入應用能力及認識傳統中華文化與臺灣多元文化。

二、活動期間

（一）本研習班於2022年10月15日至12月3日辦理，共8週，每週六、日，每天2小時，總時數30小時。

（二）本研習班上課時間分為上午班及下午班，上課時間如下：

1、上午班：臺灣時間上午9時至11時。

2、下午班：臺灣時間下午3時至5時。

三、參加資格：年滿12足歲至未滿24歲居住海外之青年，年齡計算至報名參加該活動開班日，具僑居國護照或僑居身分加簽，目前居住於海外，有高度學習華語文意願者，且持有僑胞卡或i僑卡者。

四、報名程序

（一）報名及期限：自8月16日起開始受理報名，至9月16日或人數額滿即截止。

（二）報名方式：於報名截止日前至本會「僑務活動報名系統」（網址：<https://register.ocac.gov.tw/apply/page/id/2022LSP>）報名，學員報名資料將由我國駐外館處及海外僑教中心進行初審，由本會進行複審，並將於10月上旬前發函各駐外館處及海外僑教中心通知錄取結果，及公告於「僑務活動報名系統」。

五、課程內容

（一）華語文教學。

（二）中文電腦輸入教學與網路應用課程：

課程搭配使用本會全球華文網（www.huayuworld.org）之資源與活動

使學生透過課堂活動學習華語及電腦中文輸入。

(三) 文化課程、臺灣探索及臺灣高科技產業介紹：

除語言課程外亦提供文化課程。文化課程內容如書法、紙藝、臉譜、華語歌曲、臺灣民間信仰介紹、臺灣歷史、臺灣美食，使學生能學習中華文化之內涵；臺灣探索為擴增實境導覽，使學生透過科技更了解臺灣文化內涵；承辦單位將設計5門課程，學生須至少選擇2門課程；臺灣高科技產業介紹將撥放介紹影片，讓學員對臺灣科技發展有更深的認識。

(四) 招生講座：

1. 於網站上介紹來臺升學之管道（如海外聯合招生委員會）、大學校院類型、各學群與未來出路及本會專班介紹（如「產學攜手合作僑生專班」及「海外青年技術訓練班-二年制副學士學位班」），讓學員對來臺升學有初步認識。
2. 為鼓勵學員來臺升學，承辦單位將另規劃3場升學講座，邀請國內在學僑生上線分享在臺就學經驗，認識臺灣讀書環境，每場次邀請對象如下：
 - (1) 第1場次：邀請2間以上國內大學校院在學僑生上線分享，每間學校至少1人。
 - (2) 第2場次：邀請2間以上產學攜手合作僑生專班承辦學校在學僑生上線分享，每間學校至少1人。
 - (3) 第3場次：邀請海外青年技術訓練班二年制副學士學位班學校人員，上線介紹學制特色。

(五) 華語文能力測驗講座：

為鼓勵學員參加華語文能力測驗，舉辦華語文能力測驗講座，讓學員瞭解該測驗考試題型及用途。

六、研習特點

- (一) 課程採密集式設計，依序增進學員聽、說、讀、寫及中文電腦輸入

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- (二) 線上華語同步視訊課程（1位教師對5位以下學生），線上非同步自學預習與複習課程。
- (三) 小班制，報名後參加華語文能力測驗快篩系統進行分級測驗，依學生程度分級授課，並安排線上口試，準確掌握學員程度。
- (四) 研習結束後，針對各班結業成績前10%優異學員，本會將頒發獎狀及獎品，以茲鼓勵。

七、注意事項

- (一) 學員須自備電腦、網路、耳機及麥克風等。
- (二) 本研習班費用由僑務委員會負擔，研習期間必須遵守本活動各項規定，如有重大違規情事，僑務委員會得依規定予以退班。
- (三) 學員同步課程出席時數至少達總時數80%（不含始業式與結業式），完成分班及結業測驗，且學習評量及格者，本會將寄發中英文數位結業證書。

Admission Guidelines

2022 Language Study Program for Compatriot Youth (Distance Learning)

Global Weekend Class

1. Objective

To improve the Mandarin listening, speaking, reading, writing, and Chinese computer input abilities of overseas compatriot youths and increase their understanding of traditional culture and Taiwan's diverse culture.

2. Program schedule

(1) October 15th to December 3rd, 2022 (8 weeks, every Saturday and Sunday, 2 hours per day, 30 hours in total).

(2) Divided into morning classes and afternoon classes.

a. Morning class: 9 am to 11 am Taiwan time (GMT+8).

b. Afternoon class: 3 pm to 5 pm Taiwan time (GMT+8).

3. Eligibility

Overseas youth aged 12 to 24 (age calculated to the first day of class of the program signed up for), holding a passport issued by his or her country of residence or a Taiwan passport with Overseas Compatriot Identity Endorsement, currently residing overseas, with strong desire to learn Mandarin. Students should hold an Overseas Compatriot Card or I-Compatriot Card when applying for the program.

4. Application Procedures

(1) Registration date: from August 16th to September 16th or the program is full.

(2) Registration method: students should apply for the program on the website (<https://register.ocac.gov.tw/apply/page/id/2022LSP>) before the deadline; the documents provided by the students will first be reviewed by the overseas missions of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of China or Culture Centers of Taipei Economic and Cultural Offices and will then be reviewed by the OCAC. The OCAC will inform the overseas missions of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of China or Culture Centers of Taipei Economic and Cultural Offices of the admission results before mid-October, and announce the admission results on the website above.

5. Course Contents

(1) Mandarin teaching.

(2) Chinese computer input techniques and Internet application classes: The classes will use Overseas Community Affairs Council (OCAC) "Huayuworld.org" resources and activities, allowing students to learn Mandarin and character computer input

methods through class activities.

(3) Cultural Classes, Exploration in Taiwan and Introduction to Taiwan's High-tech Industry: As well as language, cultural classes will be provided. For Cultural Classes, the classes include calligraphy, paper art, oriental mask painting, Mandarin Songs, Introduction to Taiwanese Folk Beliefs, Taiwanese History and Taiwanese Culinary Delights to allow students to learn about culture; Exploration in Taiwan will involve Augmented Reality tours to allow students to learn about Taiwan's culture through technology. The undertaking units will provide at least 5 classes, students should choose at least 2 classes. For Introduction to Taiwan's High-tech Industry, an introductory film will be shown to give students a deeper understanding of Taiwan's technological development.

(4) Enrollment lecture:

I. There will be an area on the exclusive website for introducing the admission channels for studying in Taiwan (e.g. University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students), types of universities in Taiwan, academic subjects and career choices, as well as the OCAC's vocational education programs, including 3+4 Vocational Education Program for Overseas Compatriot Student", and Overseas Youths Vocational Training Program-2-Year Associate Degree, to allow preliminary understanding of the study environment in Taiwan to be gained.

II. To encourage students to undertake further study in Taiwan and increase their understanding of the study environment, the undertaking units will arrange 3 lectures. The invitees of each are as below:

a. 1st: invite current overseas compatriot students from more than 2 Taiwanese universities to share their experience of studying in Taiwan online, at least 1 student from each school.

b. 2nd: invite current overseas compatriot students from more than 2 schools undertaking the 3+4 Vocational Education Program for Overseas Compatriot Students, at least 1 student from each school.

c. 3rd: invite the representatives from the schools undertaking the Overseas Youths Vocational Training Program-2-Year Associate Degree to introduce the features of the program.

(5) Mandarin ability test lecture:

A Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) lecture will be held to encourage students to take the test by giving them an understanding of the types of questions and

uses.

6. Special Features of the Study Program

(1) The program is intensive and designed to improve students' Mandarin listening, speaking, reading, writing, and character computer input abilities.

(2) The program includes online Mandarin simultaneous classes (maximum of 5 students for 1 teacher), and asynchronous online self-study and review classes.

(3) The program is small class-based. All participants are required to take a test of the TOCFL Speedy Screening System after registration and will be placed in different classes at different levels; and an oral examination will be arranged to obtain an understanding of student Mandarin level.

(4) After the program, the OCAC will provide certificates and rewards for the top 10% of students in each class as encouragement.

7. Important Notices

(1) Students should prepare a computer, Internet and headset.

(2) The fee for this program will be borne by the OCAC. During the program, students must abide by the regulations. If there are major violations, the OCAC can expel violators according to the regulations.

(3) Students are required to attend at least 80% of hours of simultaneous classes (excluding the opening and closing ceremonies) and to finish the class grouping and completion tests. The organizer will issue a digital Certificate of Completion in Mandarin and in English to those students who complete and pass the program.
