**Subject: Invitation to Nominate Country Participants to Attend ICLPST's 167<sup>th</sup> Regular Session on Infrastructure Development and Planning**

On behalf of the International Center for Land Policy Studies and Training (ICLPST), I cordially invite your country to nominate candidates for participation in the Center's 167<sup>th</sup> Regular Session on Infrastructure Development and Planning.

The course will begin on August 21 and conclude on September 18, 2026. Your organization is invited to nominate candidates for our consideration. The Screening Committee of the Center will make the final selection of participants to this course.

To facilitate your nomination and the ICLPST's selection, please kindly observe the following regulations and guidelines:

1. Candidates must be proficient in both spoken and written English in order to be able to follow lectures and instructions conducted in English.
2. Candidates must be college graduates who are presently working as an administrator, planning or policy maker in the area of urban development, city planning, urban infrastructure planning, transportation, etc.
3. There is no age limit for the candidates, but they must be medically fit for study and travel abroad. Those who are under medication for chronic diseases have to prepare sufficient medicine for the duration of stay in Taiwan.
4. If the candidate is admitted to the course, the ICLPST provides accidental insurance. Other medical expenses not covered by the insurance shall be borne by the participant. It is highly recommended that participants obtain medical insurance prior to their departure for Taiwan.

5. To make sure all the content on the application be recognized correctly, candidates must type out all the information; a handwritten application form will not be accepted.

Please note that the ICLPST will provide for selected candidate(s) a round-trip economy-class air ticket for travel between their capital city and Taipei by the most direct route, and will provide accommodation and meals during the training period. All other air travel and personal expenses will be their responsibility. In case the selected candidate(s) fail to participate in the ICLPST's training course, they shall be responsible for the expenses related to the booking/cancellation of air tickets. All participants should have valid passports and visas (they shall apply for a visa valid at least for the duration of their stay in Taiwan) for entry into the Republic of China (Taiwan).

In addition, to better facilitate discussions among the participants as well as with lecturers, we require that every participant have a country presentation prepared to be presented in class. The topic should bear relevance to the theme of the course, with a separate portion on net zero and climate change-related issues (see the Course Outline). Presentation is limited to within 30 minutes for each presenter (adjusted to the number of participants). The course materials will be uploaded onto Google Drive. Also, they're advised to bring a portable device for the course to download the materials. Hard copies will not be provided by the ICLPST.

All candidates must fill in the enclosed Application Form and send it to ROC (Taiwan) Embassy/Representative Office in your country before June 26, 2026 for onward transmission to the ICLPST. Successful candidates will be duly notified of the ICLPST's decision (candidates not selected will not be notified). The ICLPST reserves the right of final selection of participants. Thank you very much for your kind cooperation.
