

**3. Resident Visas for Foreign Spouses of R.O.C. (Taiwan) Citizens
Without Household Registration, Foreigners, Hong Kong Residents, Macau
Residents, or Mainland Chinese Citizens**

Requirements		Description
1	Passport (original & photocopy)	Valid for 6 months with blank pages
2	Completed & signed application form	Please access the website: https://visawebapp.boca.gov.tw/ to fill out application form online and print it out.
3	Two passport-size photos in color within 6 months	3.5cm x4.5cm
4	Original and one photocopy of Certificate of Residence in the R.O.C., Alien Permanent Residence Certificate, Alien Residence Certificate, or various kinds of residence permits issued by the National Immigration Agency	The Alien Residence Certificate and residence permits must be valid for more than 6 months
5	Original and one photocopy of proof of marriage (Does not include documents issued by an Embassy or Consulate, and must be issued by a local government agencies)	1. Marriage certificates from the home country of both spouses are necessary 2. Documents issued outside of Japan and Taiwan must be authenticated by an R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas mission beforehand 3. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be accompanied by a Chinese- or English-translation version. The original language documents and the accompanying Chinese- or English-translation must be authenticated by an R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas mission

6	Health Certificate	1. The health certificate should be issued within 3 months by one of the local hospitals designated by the Centers for Disease Control of Ministry of Health and Welfare of the R.O.C. (Taiwan) or a foreign hospital. 2. Health certificates issued by hospitals outside of Taiwan or Japan must be authenticated by an R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas mission. 3. Visit the website of the Centers for Disease Control at https://www.cdc.gov.tw/En for health checkup items and the list of designated local hospitals. 4. Applicants of the following categories are not required to present the health certificate: A) both the visa applicant and the family member(s) currently investing or employed as white collar worker(s) in the R.O.C. (Taiwan), whom the applicant intends to join with, are from countries whose citizens are eligible for visa-waiver entry into the R.O.C. (Taiwan)
7	Japanese Residence Card (original & photocopy)	Those residing outside of Japan may be required to submit additional documents on case-by-case basis
8	Certificate of Residence	Certificate of residence (住民票) issued within 3 month.
9	Other additional documents may be required during processing	Additional documents may be required on a case-by-case basis

10	Application Fee (Cash Only)	Resident Visa : 10,100 JPY US National: 28,400 JPY Application Fee (Available only in Japanese)
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Processing time: 1 Week

1. For exceptional cases and those where concurrence is required from the ROC' s Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA), the amount of processing time taken is dependent upon the length of time taken by MOFA to complete its verification and approval. Under such circumstances, our officers will advise applicants independently on the actual processing time required depending on the nature of the case.

2. Visas are issued as stipulated by Article 12 of the Statute Governing Issuance of ROC Visas for Foreign Passports. As a sovereign nation, the ROC has the right to refuse applications for visas without providing any explanation for such decisions; visa application fee is not refundable.

3. Documents produced outside of the R.O.C. (Taiwan) must be authenticated by an R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas mission; if produced in Mainland China must be authenticated by Straits Exchange Foundation. Documents that are in languages other than Chinese or English must be accompanied by a Chinese- or English-translation version. The original-language documents and the accompanying Chinese- or English-translation version must be authenticated by an R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas mission.

4. Those who enter the R.O.C. (Taiwan) without a visa or with a landing visa and those who currently stay in the R.O.C. (Taiwan) as blue-collar workers may not apply for a Resident Visa on the ground of joining spouse.

5. Those who enter the R.O.C. (Taiwan) on a Resident Visa must apply for an Alien Resident Certificate and Re-entry Permit at [local service centers of National Immigration Agency](#) within 30 days from the next day of arrival. Duration of stay is noted on the Alien Resident Certificate.
