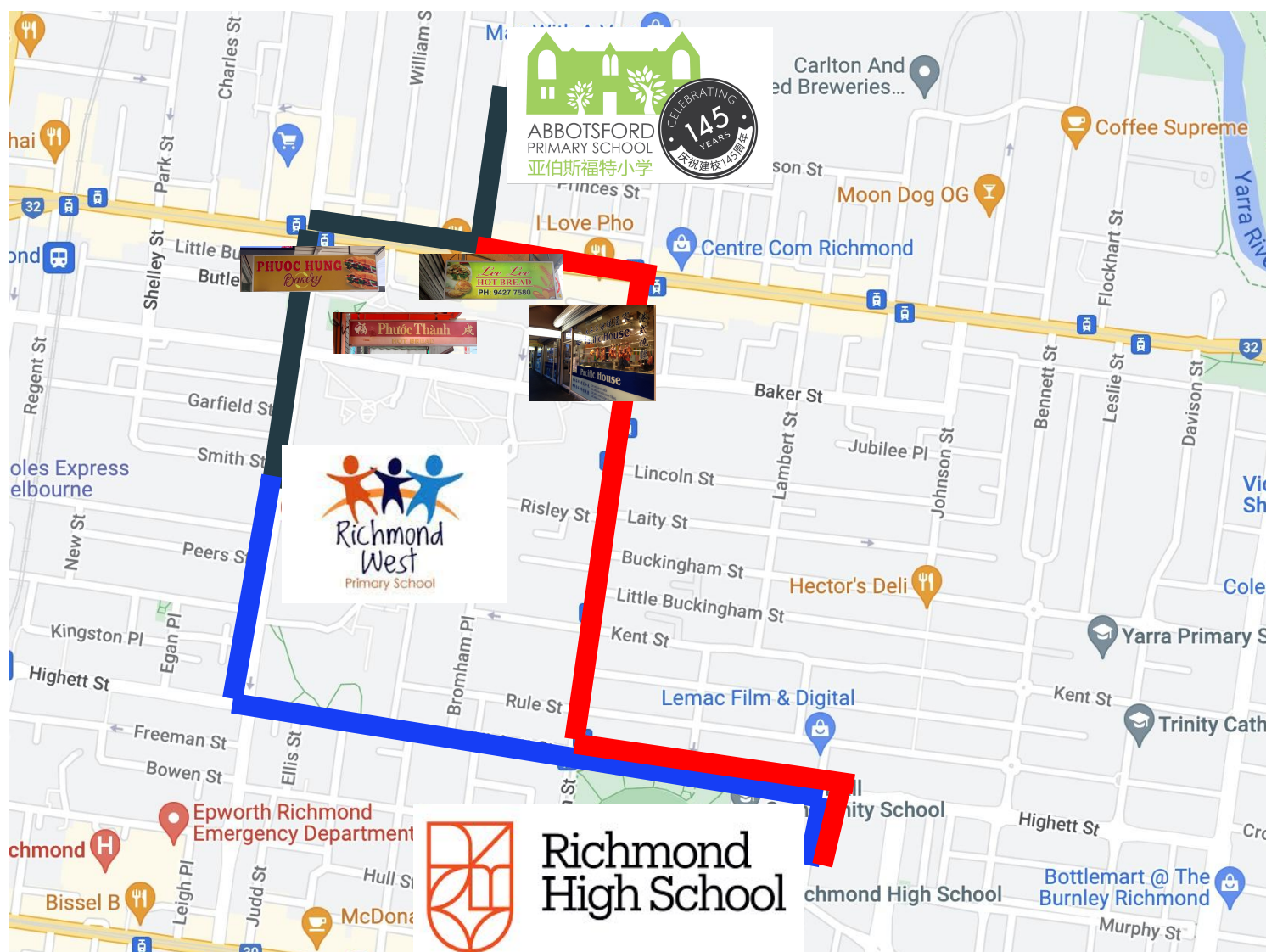

### KEYNOTE SPEAKER BIOS

#### **Associate Professor Kathleen Heugh**



**Kathleen Heugh**, Centre for Research in Educational and Social Inclusion at the University of South Australia, is a socio-applied linguist specialising in bilingualism and multilingualism (including translanguaging). She researches students use of their bi-/multilingual capabilities for translating and exchanging knowledge (transknowledging) in classrooms in Africa, Asia and Australia. She focuses on the relationship between English used as the Medium of Instruction (EMI), a second (bilingual) medium of instruction, and students' bi-/multilingual home languages. She has undertaken system-wide assessment, evaluation, and language teacher education in many countries.

#### **Mr. Andrew Scrimgeour**



**Andrew Scrimgeour** has undertaken research and development of Chinese curriculum and Chinese teacher professional learning since the early 1980s. He developed the Australian Curriculum for Chinese (2011-14). He undertakes research and presents internationally on issues in Chinese language education with a focus on literacy development, and curriculum design for Chinese language learning in schools, including in intensive language learning contexts. He co-authored *Teaching Chinese as a Second Language: The Way of the Learner* with Dr Jane Orton in 2019.

#### **Dr. Xuan (Anne) Li 李璇 博士**



**Dr Xuan (Anne) Li** specialises in Chinese-English bilingual education, focussing on the development of effective 'bilanguage and biliteracy' teaching and learning. Her research includes Chinese bilingual schools in Australia and North America. Drawing on international best practices, she has developed a 'functional bilingual teaching and learning framework' for curriculum, pedagogy and materials development (including translanguaging strategies). She has undertaken a comprehensive review of program design, curriculum and materials used for Chinese-English bilingual education worldwide; and she analyses internationally available proxy-standards setting guides for Chinese language learning levels and interprets these for use in Australian schools.

### SATURDAY SESSION ABSTRACTS

#### **Keynote Address 1 - Associate Professor Kathleen Heugh**

*Bilingual and biliteracy pedagogies in Chinese Bilingual Programs*

This presentation will outline what we know from international research about best practices in bilingual education. The critical role of biliteracy development, and the conditions which are needed for successful development of high level biliteracy (from Reception through Year 8) will be highlighted. Contemporary discussions and debates about translanguaging pedagogies, their affordances and risks, will also be addressed, as these are relevant to the teaching and learning of Chinese in the Australian context. The presentation concludes with a discussion of the role of 'transknowledging' in bilingual and CLIL programs for bilingual learning across the curriculum.

#### **Roundtable Discussion 1 - Mr. Andrew Scrimgeour**

*Pedagogies in Chinese bilingual education - good practice and challenges in the classroom*

This session is an opportunity for teachers engage with ideas raised in the keynote and to share their thoughts and experience and discuss insights gained from the classroom observations yesterday.

#### **Keynote Address 2 - Mr. Andrew Scrimgeour & Dr Xuan (Anne) Li**

*A review of curriculum frameworks and performance standards - what's best for Chinese bilingual education?*

This shared presentation will examine the purpose and nature of language curriculum frameworks used both in Australia and internationally for designing Chinese language programs and assessing progress in learning. It explores issues in framing curriculum for intensive Chinese language learning contexts and introduces a range of international standards frameworks that might be useful in benchmarking progress in school-based intensive contexts, and considers implications of developing standards-based curriculum for effective bilingual teaching & learning.

#### **Roundtable Discussion 2 - Associate Professor Kathleen Heugh**

*What standards are we setting? What are our needs? Are we measuring the right sort of things in our learners?*

This session explores issues with the application of second language curriculum to immersion contexts and explores the potential of adapting a more literacy focussed languages curriculum model, and modes of application of a standards based curriculum in a Chinese immersion contexts.
