TAIWAN FELLOWSHIPS, SCHOLARSHIP AND OTHER OPPORTUNITIES

Approximately 1,200 awards are provided annually for undergraduate students, postgraduate students, and researchers from across the world to study or conduct advanced research in Taiwan. Foreign English teachers are also welcome in Taiwan.



Taiwan's universities have been steadily climbing and achieving greater global prominence in recent years, establishing Taipei City as one of Asia's leading higher education hubs.

In Taiwan, students can pursue higher learning at two-year and four-year colleges, and universities. University undergraduate programs usually require four years of study; graduate programs leading to a master's degree require one to four years, and doctorate programs require two to seven years. Some programs require an internship that can be as short as one or two months or as long as two years.



TAIWAN'S EDUCATION SYSTEM

CHOOSING WHERE TO APPLY AND STUDY

The curriculum at most universities focuses on academic studies and research. Universities of technology focus on training practical and specific skills. A wide range of colleges and universities welcome international applicants. Applicants can choose a college or university based on their personal interests and the courses offered. A list of universities and colleges, public and private, can be found on the Study in Taiwan (www.studyintaiwan.org) website.

COSTS OF STUDYING IN TAIWAN

Taiwan is well-known as a country where you can enjoy high quality education and modern living at affordable costs. Typical costs for studying in Taiwan are set out below:

2 AFFORDABLE TUITION AND GENEROUS SCHOLARSHIPS

Taiwan's universities offer top-quality education while their tuition is inexpensive and affordable. Generally speaking, tuition for undergraduate program is around USD 1,500-1,800 per semester while tuition for graduate program is around USD 1,600-2,000 per semester. Taiwan's government and universities also provide enormous scholarships to attract global excellent students.

LEARN MANDARIN

Living and studying is the best way to learn Mandarin, as you will constantly be experiencing it in daily life. If you study in Taiwan, you can pursue a higher degree and learn Mandarin at the same time.

Taiwan is a world leader in various fields particularly technology and healthcare. Scholarship opportunities offered to Filipino students will cultivate talents in these fields to elevate the local technology industry.

According to the 2018 Freedom in the World Report made by Freedom House, 88 of 195 nations around the world were classified as free. Taiwan was amongst these free nations, receiving a score of 93 out of 100 and scored especially high in the areas of political rights and civil liberties.

Taiwan's medical service is ranked as No. 3, next to the USA and Germany. In addition, Taiwan is highly praised for its outstanding National Health Insurance System. Overseas students have the access to the insurance scheme and can visit any specialist in Taiwan if it is needed.

Schools and employers all over the world recognized degree from Taiwan universities. No Chinese language skills are required for Taiwan offers 66 English-taught Bachelor's degree programs, 263 English-taught master's programs, 148 English-taught doctoral programs in 2018.

TAIWAN FOREIGN ENGLISH TEACHER PROGRAM Opportunities for Filipino teachers

TFETP was launched by the Ministry of Education (MOE) to recruit foreign English teachers and teaching assistants to create more opportunities for Taiwanese students to learn English in schools nationwide.

ELIGIBILITY

FOREIGN ENGLISH TEACHER

- 1. The official or common language of the nation (as the nationality shown on the passport) where the applicant is from must be English. Identification of the official or common language of a nation is issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Republic of China (Taiwan).
- 2. Hold a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited university or college.
- 3. Hold a state-issued teaching license or certificate.
- 4. The applicant should provide a criminal record certificate/police check issued after January 1, 2022 from relevant authorities in his or her home country or the country he or she currently resides in. The certificate must include the name of the applicant, the date of issuance, and state that the applicant has no criminal record.
- 5. If the applicant has dual nationality (ROC Taiwan citizen and other foreign nationality), please use the foreign nationality to apply.

FOREIGN ENGLISH TEACHING ASSISTANT

- 1. The official or common language of the nation (as the nationality shown on the passport) where the applicant is from must be English.

 Identification of the official or common language of a nation is issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Republic of China (Taiwan).
- 2.Hold a master's degree or higher from an accredited university or college, or hold a bachelor's degree in related department fields with at least two years of relevant work experience, or hold a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited university or college within the Top 500 World University Rankings.
- 3. The applicant should provide a criminal record certificate/police check issued after January 1, 2022 from relevant authorities in his or her home country or the country he or she currently resides in. The certificate must include the name of the applicant, the date of issuance, and state that the applicant has no criminal record.
- 4. If the applicant has dual nationality (ROC Taiwan citizen and other foreign nationality), please use the foreign nationality to apply.

REQUIREMENTS

FOREIGN ENGLISH TEACHER

- 1. Passport
- 2. **Degree Certificate:** Applicants should obtain a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited university or college.
- 3. State-Issued Teaching License/Certificate
- 4. Police Clearance Certificate: must be issued after January 1, 2022
- 5. Statement of Purpose: A statement of purpose within 700-1500 words.
- 6. **Teaching Demonstration Video:** The video shall be 4–5 minutes in length (the part over 5 minutes may not be evaluated) and include you teaching a specific topic, concept, or a particular skill. We expect to observe your teaching style, teaching logic, teaching skills, and teaching strategies through the video.
- 7. **Two Recommendation Letters:** These can be from your teachers, professors, previous or current managers, and colleagues, who have known you for a period of time and know about your performance at work.

FOREIGN ENGLISH TEACHING ASSISTANT

- 1. Passport
- 2. **Degree Certificate:** Applicants should obtain a master's degree or higher from an accredited university or college, or hold a bachelor's degree in related department fields with at least two years of relevant work experience, or hold a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited university or college within the Top 500 World University Rankings.
- 3. Proof of Relevant Work Experience: If you do not hold a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited university or college within the Top 500 World University Rankings, or hold a master's degree or higher from an accredited university or college, you must have at least two years of relevant work experience, and please provide valid proof of your work experience, such as appointment letters and certificates of employment.
- 4. Police Clearance Certificate: must be issued after January 1, 2022
- 5. Statement of Purpose: A statement of purpose within 700-1500 words.
- 6. **Teaching Demonstration Video:** The video shall be 4-5 minutes in length (the part over 5 minutes may not be evaluated) and include you teaching a specific topic, concept, or a particular skill.
- 7.**Two Recommendation Letters:** These can be from your teachers, professors, previous or current managers, and colleagues, who have known you for a period of time and know about your performance at work.

PART 4 TAIWAN EXPERIENCE EDUCATION PROGRAM Internship Opportunities

In 2015, Taiwan's Ministry of Education launched the Taiwan Experience Education Program (TEEP) to encourage more international students to participate in short-term professional internship projects organized by Taiwanese universities and colleges. TEEP also allows international students to gain an in-depth educational experience in Taiwan, while also preparing themselves for the Asian job market.

The wide range of programs under TEEP provides students from all backgrounds opportunities to immerse themselves in the operations of key Taiwan companies and industries. Moreover, TEEP helps students find relevant and useful job placements at various companies. In these positions, students will gain firsthand knowledge that will put them well on their way in the business world. To ease participants into their internships in Taiwan, TEEP also features cultural immersion activities to improve language and cultural fluency. All participants are provided with high-quality dormitory accommodations, as well as opportunities to learn to speak Mandarin Chinese.





PART7 INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AND DEVELOPMENT FUND Scholarship

Amongst many other missions, Taiwan International Cooperation and Development Fund (ICDF) aims to assist Taiwan's partner countries, in achieving sustainable development. Taiwan ICDF provides scholarships for higher education and has developed degree programs in cooperation with renowned partner universities in Taiwan.

Applications must be submitted to Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in the Philippines between **January 1 to March 15**.

This scholarship grants one round trip economy class plane ticket, housing, tuition fees, insurance fees, textbook fees and a monthly allowance of NTD15,000 for master degree and NTD17,000 for doctoral degree students.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants with the minimum of undergraduate degree diploma, who wish to pursue master or doctoral degree in Taiwan. The applicants must apply to our **partner programs**, which all programs are taught in English. This year, there are 27 available study programs available for Filipino applicants.

PART8 TAIWAN MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (MOE) Scholarship

Taiwan offers around 66 English-taught programs at bachelor's level, 263 at master's level, and 148 at the doctoral level.

Among these programs are within the fields of agriculture & fishery, business management, engineering, nature & social science, culture, humanity, medicine and public health.

Applications must be submitted to Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in the Philippines between **February 1 to April 30**.

This scholarship grants a NTD40,000 tuition waiver per semester and a monthly stipend of NTD15,000 for bachelor's and NTD20,000 for master's and doctoral degree students.

ELIGIBILITY

- A. Applicants must be a Filipino national with a secondary school graduation diploma or post-secondary degree(s), with an excellent academic record, and be of good moral character.
- B. A person in any of the following categories is ineligible to apply:
 - 1. An R.O.C. national or an overseas Chinese student.
 - 2. A person who already has and is continuing to maintain student status at any university/college in Taiwan or who has already registered to begin studies at such a university/college. This restriction does not apply to a student who will be graduating after completing a degree that year. They may apply for a Taiwan Scholarship to pursue a higher degree.
 - 3. A person who has already studied in Taiwan for a degree at the same level as the one in which they currently intend to enroll.
 - a. An exchange student or dual/joint degree student who has been admitted to a university/college in Taiwan in accordance with an academic cooperation agreement between that university/college and an overseas university/college.

- b. A person who has already been a Taiwan Scholarship recipient for a total of five years.
- c. A person who has ever previously had their Taiwan Scholarship or MOE Huayu Enrichment Scholarship revoked.
- 4. A person who has received any other scholarship or subsidy from any Taiwan Government institution (organization) or any education institution in Taiwan.
- C. Applicants must apply directly to the university/college for admission within the application deadline. Each university/college sets its own application deadline.

PART 9 HUAYU ENRICHMENT PROGRAM Scholarship

Taiwan is an ideal place for international students who want to learn Mandarin Chinese, also called Mandarin, Huayu, Guoyu, Hanyu, Putonghua, and Zhongwen in Chinese-speaking communities around the world. Taiwan is also an ideal place for learning traditional Chinese characters, which allows you to better connect with classic Chinese literature and culture. Furthermore, learning the characters also allows you to do handwritten communication with people who speak other Chinese dialects.

Applications must be submitted to Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in the Philippines between **February 1 to March 31**.

This scholarship grants a **monthly stipend** of NTD25,000.

Applicants may apply for 2-month summer programs, or 3, 6, 9 or 12 month grants.

ELIGIBILITY

Filipino applicants above the age of 18, who possess a high school diploma or above, have shown excellent academic performance, and are of good moral character, are eligible. Candidates with one of the following qualifications may NOT apply:

- a. Is an overseas Chinese student or a national of the R.O.C.
- b. Is currently registered as a student at a Mandarin Language Center or has sought a degree from a university or college in Taiwan.
- c. Has already received a HES or a Taiwan Scholarship, in the past.
- d. Is an exchange student to Taiwan, during the scholarship period.
- e. Is currently receiving financial benefits from the Taiwan government or another educational institution.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIPS




I am not a Filipino citizen, can I apply for these scholarships?

All three scholarship programs are only intended for Filipino citizens. For other nationalities, they may check the TECO office in their respective residences.



Does TECO offer bachelor degree scholarship programs?

The MOE scholarship is open to those who would like to apply for undergraduate, master's, and PhD programs. The ICDF scholarship is only open to master's and PhD applicants.



Is there an age requirement?

Applicants must only be at least 18 years old upon application.



Do I have to be a college graduate before I can apply?

Under the MOE scholarship program, applicants of bachelor's degrees must be graduates of senior high school, applicants for the master's and PhD degrees should have finished a college degree. For Huayu (Mandarin) Enrichment Program, applicants should be at least secondary education graduates.



Can I apply for more than 1 scholarship program?

Applicants are only allowed to apply for one scholarship program at a time.




Can I apply to any program and university under the scholarship?

Under the ICDF scholarship, applicants can only apply for selected programs and university. For those interested in applying for the MOE scholarship, you are free to choose any program and university.

How can I authenticate my documents?

For information on TECO authentication. you can visit our website through https://www.roc-taiwan.org/ph. Please make sure that your diploma has an English translation.

Can I submit my documents online or via email?

Documents must be sent in hard copies. Submissions via an authorized representative or couriers are allowed (express delivery services are not allowed, i.e Grab, Lalamove, Mr. Speedy).

Can I submit a TOEFL or IELTS certificate in place of the "English as Medium of Instruction" certificate?

Yes, our office can accept a valid TOEFL or IELTS certificate in place of the "English as Medium of Instruction" certificate. TOEIC and other online English exams are not accepted.

My chosen program is not completely taught in English. Can I still apply for this program?

> Yes however, students who will apply for programs not completely taught in English may be required to take the TOCFL Exam after their first semester.
