

REQUIREMENTS	DESCRIPTION
Application form	Go to website: https://visawebapp.boca.gov.tw . Fill out the application form online and print it out. Make sure the application form shows a bar code on it. Sign the application form.
Two color passport-size photos	Paste on the application form two color passport-size photos with a white background taken within 6 months.
Passport and one photocopy of the passport	The passport must be valid for at least 6 months and there are blank pages left in it. One photocopy of the passport bio-page including the holder's picture is required.
Original and one photocopy of health certificate	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The health certificate should be issued within 3 months by one of the local hospitals designated by the Centers for Disease Control of Ministry of Health and Welfare of the R.O.C. (Taiwan) or a foreign hospital. (Accredited hospital and clinics for health certificates) 2. Health certificates issued by foreign hospitals must be authenticated by an R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas mission. 3. Visit the website of the Centers for Disease Control at https://www.cdc.gov.tw/En for health checkup items and the list of designated local hospitals.
One photocopy of the certificate of registration of the inviting religious organization or corporation	Religious organizations refer to temples, churches or institutes which are legally registered in the R.O.C. (Taiwan).
Original and one photocopy of highest education diploma and transcripts	For diplomas and transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English, a Chinese- or English-translation version is also required.
Original and one photocopy of letter of invitation	<p>The letter of invitation should be issued by the inviting religious organization, with person-in-charge's signature and the organization's seal, and contain the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. proof that the inviting organization is a legally registered, non-profit and properly operational entity;

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. the reason for inviting the visa applicant; 3. the visa applicant's name, nationality, date of birth, religion, intended period of stay as well as religious activities and activity dates in the R.O.C. (Taiwan); 4. the list of foreign religious personnel who are invited by the same religious organization and still stay in the R.O.C. (Taiwan) as well as the types of visas they hold; 5. Affidavit pertaining to the content of the letter of invitation.
<p>Original and one photocopy of the applicant's certificate in religious work</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicants must possess an official capacity as religious personnel such as Pastor, Father, Brother, Sister, Monk, Nun, Imam, etc. In the event that according to a religion's administrative practice, no certificate is issued to its personnel, proof provided by the highest administration where the applicant serves or by the organization to which the applicant belongs is required. 2. The certificate should contain the applicant's name, nationality, religion, date of induction, and attests to the applicant's capacity as a religious worker at the time of visa application. 3. Buddhism Monks and Nuns are required to present also the original and one photocopy of the certificate of vow.
<p>Original and one photocopy of the applicant's credentials</p>	<p>The credentials should be issued by the religious organization to which the applicant belongs, signed by the person-in-charge, and contain the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. the applicant's name, nationality and religion. 2. the chronicle of more than 2 years of religious work prior to the time of visa application.
<p>Other supporting documents</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To be decided on a case-by-case basis. Applicants who apply for a Resident Visa after having arrived in the R.O.C. (Taiwan) are required to present also one photocopy of the Visitor Visa and the immigration

entry stamp.
