Visitor Visa for Business Purpose

REQUIREMENTS

□ <u>Application form</u>

Go to website: https://visawebapp.boca.gov.tw. Fill out the application form online and print it out. Make sure the application form shows a bar code on it. Sign the application form.

□ <u>Two colored passport- size photos</u>

Place two (2) glossy, 2"x1.5", white background photos that were taken within the last six (6) months on the application form.

□ Passport

The passport must be valid for at least 6 months with blank pages. One photocopy of the passport bio page with the applicant's photo is required.

Business certificates or evidence of business activities

- □ <u>Request letter (dispatch letter) from applicant's company</u>
- Company's Certificate of Business Name Registration and SEC <u>Registration of the Organization</u> (for applicants employed in local companies in the Philippines)

□ <u>Certificate of Employment</u>:

- (1) The company's letter of employment and job assignment, bearing the employer's or HR director's signature and contact information.
- (2)Self-employed applicants must provide a certificate of business registration as well as proof of sufficient means to cover the applicant's expenses while in Taiwan.
- Invitation letter from a Taiwanese company or organization (must include daily schedules, accommodation details, and contact information of the contact person in Taiwan).
- Taiwanese company's registration certificate issued by ROC (Taiwan) Government
- <u>Evidence of business activities</u>, such as business transactions between two companies, ongoing letters, and trading records (LC, remittance receipt...etc.)
- □ Financial Proof /Bank Statement

- □ PSA Birth Certificate (only those with Philippine passports)
- <u>PSA Marriage Certificate (if a female applicant is married; only those with</u> <u>Philippine passports)</u>

For Non-Filipino applicants:

- In addition to the preceding requirements (with the exception of birth and marriage certificates), foreign nationals who have a long-term or permanent residency status in the Philippines who are applying for a visitor visa must also submit a copy of their Alien Certificate of Registration (ACR I-Card) issued by the Philippine government.
- □ While those foreign nationals applying for visas holding short-term (temporary) visas in the Philippines must include their confirmed onward or return tickets as well as their travel itinerary in Taiwan.
- Nationals from Afghanistan, Algeria, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cameroon, Gambia, Ghana, India (Identity Certificate), Iraq, Nepal, Niger, Nigeria, Pakistan, Senegal, Somalia, Sri Lanka, Syria applying for visitor visas, please see <u>here</u>.
- □ <u>Other supporting documents</u>

The applicant will be scheduled for an interview if required. Other additional documents may be required during processing.

NOTICES

- 1. All documents submitted to this office must be original with one (1) set of photocopies on A4-sized paper. Original documents are to be returned after review.
- 2. Visas are issued as stipulated by Article 12 of the Statute governing the issuance of ROC visas for foreign passports. As a sovereign nation, the ROC has the right to refuse visa applications without providing any explanation for such decisions; the visa application fee is not refundable.
