## Visitor Visa for Employment Seeking Purpose

## REQUIREMENTS

□ <u>Application form</u>

Go to website: https://visawebapp.boca.gov.tw. Fill out the application form online and print it out. Make sure the application form shows a bar code on it. Sign the application form.

□ <u>Two colored passport- size photos</u>

Place two (2) glossy, 2"x1.5", white background photos that were taken within the last six (6) months on the application form.

□ <u>Passport</u>

The passport must be valid for at least 6 months with blank pages. One photocopy of the passport bio page with the applicant's photo is required.

- <u>Completed & signed "ROC EMPLOYMENT-SEEKING VISA APPLICATION</u> <u>CHECKLIST"</u>
  Download "ROC EMPLOYMENT-SEEKING VISA APPLICATION CHECKLIST."
- □ Applicant must fulfill one of the 3 following conditions and provide the according proof:
  - (1) Being employed and the average monthly salary within the past six (6) months is not less than \$47,971NTD:
    - Proof of employment
    - Proof of the average monthly wage or compensation for the past six months
  - (2) Graduated from one of the world's top universities identified by the ROC Ministry of Education (please view the list at <u>https://depart.moe.edu.tw/ed2500/News\_Content.aspx?n=0BC849A9304</u> <u>9621E&sms=E0AA294AA6810C0B&s=A3C411918479C683</u>), within the last one (1) year and are not yet employed:
    - Highest educational diploma and transcript
  - (3) Deemed otherwise eligible by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) after consultations with the central competent authority of the ROC (Taiwan) Government.
    - Permit issued by MOFA
- □ Proof of sufficient financial resources (at least NT\$100,000 or equivalent)

- □ Evidence of health and comprehensive medical insurance for the entire duration of stay in the ROC (Taiwan)
- □ PSA Birth Certificate (only those with Philippine passports.)
- PSA Marriage Certificate (if a female applicant is married; only those with Philippine passports)
- Proof of no criminal record issued by competent authorities of the applicant's <u>country</u>
- (1) Documents should be issued within one (1) year prior to the application for a Resident Visa. If the document has an expiration date, the resident visa application must be submitted before that date.
- (2) A Chinese or English translation of any document written in a language other than English is required and must be authenticated by a R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas mission.
- □ <u>Other supporting documents</u>
  - (1) Plan for seeking employment
  - (2) The applicant will be scheduled for an interview if required. Other additional documents may be required during processing.

## NOTICES

- 1. All documents submitted to this office must be original with one (1) set of photocopies on A4-sized paper. Original documents are to be returned after review.
- 2. Visas are issued as stipulated by Article 12 of the Statute governing the issuance of ROC visas for foreign passports. As a sovereign nation, the ROC has the right to refuse visa applications without providing any explanation for such decisions; the visa application fee is not refundable.
