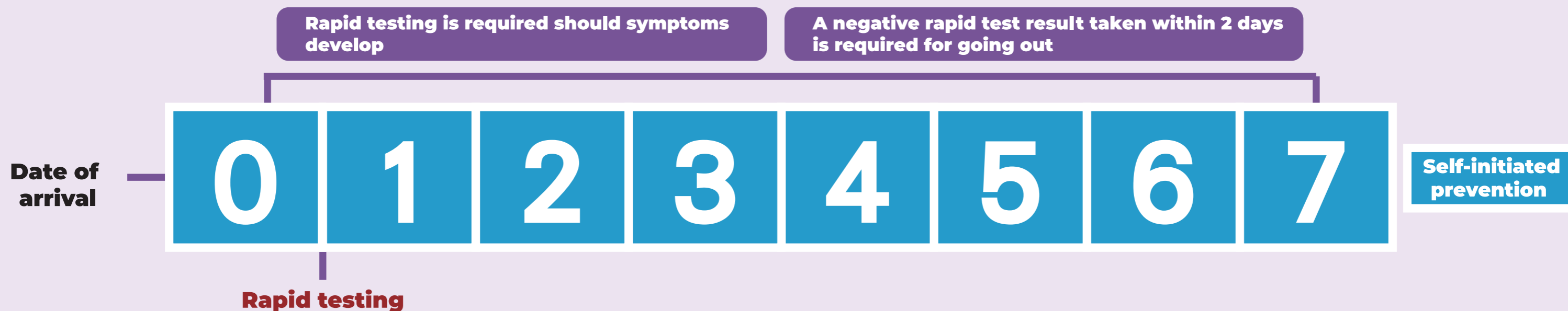


Quarantine Mandate Lifted

with Implementation Date to Be Decided Depending on the Development of the Epidemic (Scheduled to Take Effect on October 13 after One Week of Observation)

7 days of self-initiated prevention for arrivals



- ◆ Home Quarantine Notice will no longer be issued.
- ◆ Epidemic prevention vehicles and quarantine hotel policies will be adjusted.
- ◆ Electronic fencing and monitoring measures will be suspended, and home quarantine designation will no longer be marked in the National Health Insurance system.
- ◆ Home quarantine services from local governments will be suspended.
- ◆ At-home rapid testing measures: Four rapid test kits will be given to arrivals aged 2 and older by staff at international airports/ports upon arrival. One test should be done on the day of arrival or the first day of the self-initiated prevention period (D0/D1).
A negative result taken within two days is required for going out.
