II. 申請資格

外國學生申請資格係依據教育部「外國學生來臺就學辦法」之規定，辦法如經修訂，將以教育部公告為準 (<http://www.edu.tw/>)。

1. 身分規定

申請者須符合中華民國教育部「外國學生來臺就學辦法」第二及第三條所稱外國學生身分。符合下列資格者，得以外國學生身分申請入學：

(1) 具外國國籍且未曾具有中華民國國籍，於申請時並不具僑生資格者。

(2) 具外國國籍，於申請時已連續居留海外(不含香港、澳門及大陸地區)六年以上且每歷年在臺灣停留時間不超過120日，並符合下列規定者：

- ① 申請時兼具中華民國國籍者，應自始未曾在臺設有戶籍。
- ② 申請前曾兼具中華民國國籍，於申請時已不具中華民國國籍者，應自內政部許可喪失中華民國國籍之日起至申請時已滿八年。
- ③ 前二款均未曾以僑生身分在臺就學，且未於107學年度接受海外聯合招生委員會分發。

- (3)具外國國籍且原具中華民國國籍，並於2011年2月1日前已提出申請喪失中華民國國籍滿八年者。
- (4)具外國國籍，兼具香港或澳門永久居留資格，且未曾在臺設有戶籍，申請時於香港、澳門或海外(不含大陸地區)連續居留滿六年以上且每曆年在臺灣停留時間不超過120日。
- (5)曾為大陸地區人民且具外國國籍，且未曾在臺設有戶籍，申請時已連續居留海外(不含香港、澳門及大陸地區)六年以上且每曆年在臺灣停留時間不超過120日。
- (6)依教育合作協議，由外國政府、機構或學校遴薦來臺的外國國民，其自始未曾在臺設有戶籍且經主管教育行政機關核准者。

❖以上所定六年、八年，以擬入學當學期起始日期(秋季班為8月1日，春季班為2月1日)為終日計算之。

❖有關連續居留海外期間計算方式，本校係依教育部「外國學生來臺就學辦法」第二及第三條相關規定辦理。

❖以上所稱中華民國國籍係依中華民國「國籍法」第二條*認定之(*如下)。中華民國國籍法第二條規定，有下列各款情形之一者，屬中華民國國籍：

- 一、出生時父或母為中華民國國民。
 - 二、出生於父或母死亡後，其父或母死亡時為中華民國國民。
 - 三、出生於中華民國領域內，父母均無可考，或均無國籍者。
 - 四、歸化者。
- 前項第一款及第二款之規定，於本法修正公布時之未成年人，亦適用之。

❖根據「僑生回國就學及輔導辦法」規定有下列各款情形之一者，為具僑生身分，不符合外國學生申請入學資格。

- 一、曾於臺灣師範大學僑生先修部(前為僑大先修班)就讀。
- 二、曾於臺灣以僑生身分申請或就讀。
- 三、報名「海外聯合招生委員會」所舉辦之僑生考試，且已登記志願獲分發。

(2)具有教育部「入學大學同等學力認定標準」與我國學制相當之同等學力資格者。

(3)以「入學大學同等學力認定標準」第六條「曾於大學校院擔任專業技術人員、於專科學校或高級中等學校擔任專業及技術教師」或第七條「就專業領域具卓越成就表現者」經本校招生委員會審議通過者，得申請入學本校學士班、碩士班。

(4)持國外或香港、澳門或大陸地區專科以上學校畢(肄)業學歷者，須符合「入學大學同等學力認定標準」第九條之相關規定，其畢(肄)業學校須經教育部列入參考名冊或為當地國政府權責機關或專業評鑑團體所認可，且入學資格、修業年限及修習課程均與我國同級同類學校規定相當，並經本校招生委員會審議後認定為國內同級同類學校修業年級。

(5)國內公立或已立案之私立大學或符合教育部採認規定之國外大學肄業生，申請進入本校繼續修讀學士班者，應符合修業期程規定：

- ①修業累計滿二個學期以上者，得申請轉入本校學士班二年級上學期；
- ②修業累計滿三個學期以上者，得申請轉入本校學士班二年級下學期；
- ③修業累計滿四個學期以上者，得申請轉入本校學士班三年級上學期；
- ④修業累計滿五個學期以上者，得申請轉入本校學士班三年級下學期。

❖畢業年級相當於臺灣高級中等學校二年級之國外或香港澳門地區同級同類學校畢業生得申請本校學士班，惟入學後依本校學則規定應增加畢業學分數12學分。

❖因各國學制不同，應屆畢業申請者需確定能於以下指定時間期限內領取正式畢業證書及歷年成績單，並完成經我國駐外館處驗證蓋章程序，方能申請報考。
秋季班應屆畢業申請者：2018年8月31日；春季班應屆畢業申請者：2019年1月31日。

如違反上述任一條件之申請者，經查證屬實者，撤銷其入學資格、開除學籍或撤銷其本校畢業資格，且不發給任何學歷證明。

2.學歷規定

- (1)須符合教育部採認規定之高中、大學或獨立學院畢業(請參考教育部網站)。
- ①具國外高中學歷者，得申請入學本校學士班；
- ②具學士學位者，得申請入學本校碩士班；
- ③具碩士學位者，得申請入學本校博士班。

若存款證明之幣值非新臺幣或美金，申請者需自行註明匯率並換算成相當於新臺幣或美金之金額，註記於存款證明上。

②**已取得全額獎助學金之證明**：

政府或民間機構提供全額獎助學金之證明影本。

- (5) **國籍證明文件** 1 份
請繳交護照影本或國籍證明文件。如有外僑居留證者，需繳交居留證影本 1 份。
符合教育部「外國學生來臺就學辦法」第 2 條具外國國籍且（曾）兼具中華民國國籍之規定者，需另繳交近 6 年出入境紀錄、未設戶籍具結書、喪失中華民國國籍許可證明書或其他證明文件。
- (6) **學歷證明文件** 1 份（中、英文以外之語文，應加附中文或英文譯本）
- ① 學士班申請者：
- a. 新生：高中畢業學歷證明文件影本。
b. 轉學生：由原就讀學校開立之在學證明或畢業學歷證明文件影本。

③ 博士班申請者：碩士畢業學歷證明文件影本。
- ❖ 應屆畢業生申請時請繳交由其學校出具之「**預計畢業證明書**（中文或英文）」正本一份；應屆畢業生如獲錄取，則需於註冊期間繳交經驗證之畢業證書，否則將取消錄取資格。

IV. 申請結果公告

1. 開放查詢申請結果

申請結果預計於本校受理申請表件後約 1 個月後公布。申請者請於開放查詢申請結果期間，逕至報名系統登入查詢。

2. 寄發錄取通知書

申請結果公布後，本校將以電子郵件通知申請者結果，並以專函寄發紙本錄取通知書。

V. 報到及註冊入學

1. 錄取生應依錄取通知書之規定，在指定期限內將「**外國學生入學意願確認書**」回覆給本校國際教育合作處，以便安排宿舍申請及接機等服務。逾期未回覆者，將無法安排以上服務，考生不得異議。

2. 已回覆「**外國學生入學意願確認書**」之錄取生，應依錄取通知規定時間辦理註冊手續，註冊時應繳交下列文件，未繳交者不得註冊入學：

(1) **護照**（正本驗畢發還）及中華民國簽證頁影本 1 份。

(2) **學歷證明文件正本**（經學歷授予學校所在地之中華民國駐外館處或相關規定單位驗證正本 1 份；若學歷證明文件為臺灣學校所授予，則不需經由駐外機構驗證）。

① 學士班錄取者：

a. 新生：繳交高中畢業學歷證明文件。

b. 轉學生：繳交大學修業或專科畢業學歷證明文件。

② 碩士班錄取者：繳交學士畢業學歷證明文件。

③ 博士班錄取者：繳交碩士畢業學歷證明文件。

❖ 若畢業證書是中、英文以外的語文，應附經公證之中文或英文翻譯本。

(3) **歷年成績單正本**（經成績單授予學校所在地之中華民國駐外館處或相關規定單位驗證正本 1 份；若成績單為臺灣學校所授予，則不需經由駐外機構驗證）。

① 學士班錄取者：

a. 新生：繳交高中歷年成績單。

b. 轉學生：繳交大學或專科歷年成績單。

② 碩士班錄取者：繳交學士歷年成績單。

③ 博士班錄取者：繳交碩士歷年成績單。

❖ 若成績單是中、英文以外的語文，應附經公證之中文或英文翻譯本。

➢ 持大陸地區學歷者，應依「大陸地區學歷採認辦法」規定辦理。

➢ 持香港或澳門學歷者，應依「香港澳門學歷檢覈及採認辦法」規定辦理。

➢ 持其他地區學歷者：

a. 海外臺灣學校及大陸地區臺商學校之學歷同我國同級學校學歷。

b. 前二目以外之國外地區學歷，應依「大學辦理國外學歷採認辦法」規定辦理。但設校或分校於大陸地區之外國學校學歷，應經大陸地區公證處公證，並經行政院設立或指定之機構或委託之民間團體驗證。

(4) 外國學生註冊時應檢附已於國外自行投保自入境當日起至少六個月效期之醫療及傷害保險書，文件應經我國駐外單位驗證，如已具有我國全民健康保險，則檢附辦理相關保險之證明文件。具正式學籍學生有關健康保險事宜，請洽詢本校國際教育合作處（電話：+886-4-23590121 分機 28509；電子信箱：isas@thu.edu.tw）。

3. 學分抵免

申請入學前於大專校院所修習之學分，在註冊後經書面申請並由就讀系所及教務處審核通過後，將准予抵免。抵免以當年度當學期規定之時間辦理，且以一次為原則，逾期不予補辦。

申請學分抵免，需繳交經中華民國駐各國代表處驗證之成績單，系所擁有決定受理學分抵免申請與否之權力。「東海大學學生抵免學分辦法」請參考網頁：http://reg.thu.edu.tw/zh_tw/download10。

VI.其他相關規定

- 1.凡報名本招生者，即表示同意授權東海大學，得將自考生報名參加本招生所取得之個人及其相關成績資料，運用於本招生試務、註冊入學、相關研究使用及提供報名學系等相關單位使用，其餘均依照「個人資料保護法」相關規定辦理。
- 2.入學許可並不保證簽證取得，簽證須由中華民國駐外館處核給。
- 3.如經發現錄取新生有申請資格不符、舞弊情事或所繳證件有偽造、變造、假借、塗改、冒用、不實或學歷資格不具合法效力等情事，即取銷其錄取資格或開除學籍，亦不發給任何有關學業證明。如係在東海大學畢業後始發現者，除勒令繳銷其學位證書，公告取銷其畢業資格外，並應負法律責任。

- 5.外國學生不得申請就讀我國大專校院所辦理回流教育之進修學士班、碩士在職專班及其他僅於夜間、例假日授課之班別。但外國學生在臺已具有合法居留身分者或其就讀之班別屬經教育部專案核准之課程者，不在此限。
- 6.本校大一新生及轉學生不分科系、國籍、性別皆必修一學年 0 學分的基本勞作。

- 7.本校學士班學生除須於修業年限內修畢所屬學系(組)規定應修學分外，尚須通過學校及學系規定之外語能力畢業標準，方能畢業。
- 8.畢業年級相當於國內高級中等學校二年級之國外或香港、澳門同級同類學校畢業生，以同等學力資格入學本校學士班後，依本校學則規定應於規定修業年限內增加其學士班應修畢業學分數 12 學分。
- 9.本招生簡章中、英文版內容如有不一致，以中文版為準。
- 10.本申請入學係依據東海大學學則及「東海大學外國學生入學規定」辦理。

II. Eligibility

All rules and regulations indicated in this brochure regarding the qualifications for international student who intent to apply for admission to THU are subject to the “Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” administered by Ministry of Education (MOE) of R.O.C. Should there be any future revisions made in the regulations, the latest regulations announced by MOE shall prevail.

1. Applicants’ Identity

Applicants must meet the eligibility as international students pursuant to Article 2 and 3 “Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” promulgated by the MOE. Applicants who meet the following regulations can apply for admission to THU:

- (1) Those who have foreign nationality and have never held R.O.C. nationality and also who do not possess overseas Chinese student status at the time of their applications.
- (2) Those who have foreign nationality and have resided overseas (excluding Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau) continuously for no less than 6 years, and whose stays in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year, must fulfill the following requirements:
 - ① An individual who also is a national of the R.O.C., but does not hold or has not ever had a household registration in Taiwan.
 - ② An individual who also was a national of the R.O.C. but has no R.O.C. nationality at the time of their application shall have an annulled status regarding their R.O.C. nationality for no less than 8 years after an annulment of R.O.C. nationality by the Ministry of the Interior.
 - ③ Regarding individuals mentioned in the preceding two subparagraphs, they must not have studied in Taiwan as an overseas Chinese student nor received placement permission during the same year of the application by the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students
- (3) Those who once had R.O.C. nationality and applied for an annulment of their R.O.C. nationality (before February 1, 2011) for at least 8 years since the date, on which a revocation was issued by the Ministry of the Interior.
- (4) Those who have foreign nationality, concurrently holding a permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macao, have no history of a household registration record in Taiwan since birth and, at the time of application, have resided in Hong Kong, Macau, or another foreign country (excluding Mainland China) continuously for no less than 6 years, and whose stays in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year.
- (5) Those who were former citizens of Mainland China and currently hold foreign nationality, have no history of household registration record in Taiwan since birth, and at the time of application, have resided overseas continuously (excluding Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau) for no less than 6 years, and whose stays in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year.

- (6) Those who have been selected by a foreign government, organization, or school according to the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement and do not hold the household registration since birth as well as receive the approval from the designated authorized government educational institutions.

- ❖ The six and eight years calculation period as prescribed shall be calculated from the starting date of semester (for Fall semester applicants: August 1; for Spring semester applicants: February 1) as the designated due date for the time of study.
- ❖ Regarding the calculation of the duration of overseas residence continuously, THU conforms to Article 2 and 3 of “Regulations Regarding Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” formulated by the MOE.
- ❖ R.O.C. nationality mentioned above is defined in accordance with Article 2 of Nationality Law* (* see below). According to Article 2 of the ROC Nationality Law, a person shall have the nationality of the Republic of China under any of the conditions provided by the following subparagraphs:
 - ① His/her father or mother was a national of the Republic of China when he/she was born.
 - ② He/she was born after the death of his/her father or mother, and his/her father or mother was a national of the Republic of China at the time of death.
 - ③ He/she was born in the territory of the Republic of China, and his/her parents can't be ascertained or both were stateless persons.
 - ④ He/she has undergone the nationalization process.

Preceding subparagraph 1 and subparagraph 2 shall also apply to the persons who were minors at the time of the revision and promulgation of this Act.
- ❖ As stated in the “Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan”, any applicants who meet one of the following requirements are considered as overseas Chinese, and therefore are disqualified for admission applications as international students:
 - ① Anyone who has previously studied at the Division of Preparatory Programs for Overseas Chinese Students at National Taiwan Normal University (formerly known as “National University of Preparatory School for Overseas Chinese Students”).

- ② Anyone who has applied for studies or has previously studied in any school in Taiwan as an overseas Chinese.
- ③ Anyone who has taken the university entrance exam for overseas Chinese Students held by the “University Entrance Committee For Overseas Chinese Student”, and has filled out the choices for his/her placement in a university/college, and has been admitted to one of the university/college in Taiwan.

2. Applicants’ Academic Credentials

(1) International student applicants must have graduated from a high school, college/university, or an educational institute that is certified by MOE (please refer to the website of the Department of International and Cross-Strait Education, MOE) and with an academic qualification that is equivalent to the same level of academic status granted by the educational system of R.O.C.:

- ① Applicants who apply for an undergraduate program must hold a certificate of graduation obtained from a certified foreign high school;
- ② Applicants who apply for a Master’s program must hold a Bachelor’s degree obtained from a certified college/university;
- ③ Applicants who apply for a Ph.D. program must hold a Master’s degree obtained from a certified college/university.

(2) Applicants who meet the regulations stipulated in the “Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Level as Qualified for Entering University” shall be considered to have an adequate level of education to register for the new student enrollment entrance examination.

(3) Applicants who “have been employed as a professional technician at a university or tertiary college, or as a teacher of professional or technical subject(s) at a junior college or senior secondary school” as stipulated in Article 6 or who “have exceptional achievements in their professional field” as stipulated in Article 7 of the “Standard for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission” and been reviewed and given approval by the university’s admission committee will be considered to have an adequate scholastic ability and may apply for an undergraduate or a Master’s program.

(4) Applicants with an academic record from a foreign country, Hong Kong, Macao or Mainland China

Area should meet the regulation stipulated in Article 9 of the “Standard for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission”:

Students with an academic record of graduating from (or not yet completing a program at) a junior college or higher level educational institution which is included in the Ministry of Education List of Recognized Higher Education Institutions or which has been accredited by an organization authorized by the government where it is located, or by a professional accreditation body, if the educational institution’s enrollment eligibility criteria, length of prescribed programs, and curricula are all equivalent to those specified in regulations governing educational institutions of the same level and nature in Taiwan, and the educational standard of its students has been reviewed by the admission committee of the university and been determined to be equivalent to that provided by an educational institution of the same level and nature in Taiwan.

(5) Applicants who have not completed a bachelor’s degree program at any university in Taiwan or at a foreign university certified by the MOE,

- ① whose completed studies accumulated together add up to two or more semesters may transfer into the first semester of the second year.
- ② whose completed studies accumulated together add up to three or more semesters may transfer into the second semester of the second year.
- ③ whose completed studies accumulated together add up to four or more semesters may transfer into the first semester of the third year.
- ④ whose completed studies accumulated together add up to five or more semesters may transfer into the second semester of the third year.

❖ Those having completed study at a foreign or Hong Kong/Macao high school which is equal to the sophomore of a senior high school in Taiwan may apply to the undergraduate program, however, according to “Tunghai University Academic Regulations”, their required number of credits for graduation shall be increased by 12 credits to complete their study.

❖ Due to different education system in each country, applicants who graduate at the same year as the admission to THU must ensure to receive his/her diploma and academic transcripts of the academic degree and finish the authentication procedure by the R.O.C. representative office located in the country of the institution which issued the diploma/transcripts by the following deadlines.

Deadline for Fall semester applicants: August 31, 2018; for Spring semester applicants: January 31, 2019. Applicants who are able to follow all of rules indicated above are qualified to apply for admission to THU.

In the event if it's confirmed that applicants violate any of the rules indicated above after investigation, they will lose their admission status or student status at THU and no certificate of credits or a transcript will be issued by THU.

(4) Once we receive the application packet, we will send you a notice of confirmation via email within 7 working days. The application process is then completed. If application documents submitted are found incomplete or not submitted on time, or the qualification of the applicants fail to meet the THU's requirements, such applications will not be processed by THU.

- (5) All application documents submitted will not be returned, please keep a copy for your records.

6. Required Application Documents

All documents must be organized and submitted according to the following sequence without stapling.

- (4) **A financial statement** (please select one of the following ways to submit).
 - ① **An official bank statement** (in Chinese or English) **issued within 3 months** from a financial institution which indicates that the account balance is **at least NT\$60,000 (or US\$2,000)**.
If the bank statement is not under your name, a signed “**Financial Affidavit**” (Appendix 4) by your financial sponsor/guarantor is also required. If the currency of the bank statement is neither NT dollars nor US dollars, you shall do the conversion and write down the exchange rate.
 - ② **A proof/certificate of the full scholarship** granted and issued by any governments or private organizations/institutes.
- (5) **Verification of nationality**
Please submit a photocopy of your passport. The applicants who have the Taiwan Alien Residence Certificate (ARC), are also required to submit a photocopy of ARC.
If you are of foreign nationality as specified in Article 2 under the MOE’s “Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” and you also are (or were) a nationality of the R.O.C., you are required to submit additional documents to support your applications, i.e., your Certificate of Entry and Exit Records for the past 6 years, non-household registration declaration, a certificate of “Nationality Renouncement of

Republic of China”, or other relevant documents.

- (6) **Academic credentials** (a copy of the translation in Chinese or English is necessary if the original one is not in Chinese or in English).
 - ① For undergraduate program applicants:
 - a. Freshman: please submit a photocopy of a high school diploma.
 - b. Transfer: please submit a photocopy of a certificate of attendance, transfer certificate or leave-from-studies certificate of college/university.
 - ② For Master’s program applicants: please submit a photocopy of a Bachelor’s degree certificate.
 - ③ For Ph.D. program applicants: please submit a photocopy of a Master’s degree certificate.

❖ If you are graduating student, you are required to submit a “**Certificate of Expected Graduation** (either in English or Chinese)”, an official document issued by your school which indicates the expected date of your graduation from that school, in lieu of your certificate of graduation at the time of application. If you are admitted by THU, you are required to submit your original certificate of graduation at the time of registration. Please note that failure to do so will result in cancellation of your admission by THU.
- (7) **Official transcripts** (a copy of the translation in Chinese or English is necessary if the original one is not in Chinese or in English).
 - ① For undergraduate program applicants:
 - a. Freshman: please submit a photocopies of a transcript for all semesters completed in obtaining a High School diploma.
 - b. Transfer: please submit a photocopies of a transcript for all semesters completed at all colleges/universities attend.
 - ② For Master’s program applicants: please submit a photocopies of a transcript for all semesters completed in obtaining a Bachelor’s degree.
 - ③ For Ph.D. program applicants: please submit a photocopies of a transcript for all semesters completed in obtaining a Bachelor’s and Master’s degree.

❖ THU holds the right to request applicants to have their degree certificate or diploma authenticated by the ROC representative office once THU find any problem in the applicants' documents.
- (8) **A personal autobiography** (300-500 words) (in Chinese or English).

(9) **A study plan** (in Chinese or English) (only for Master's and Ph.D. program applicants).

(10) **Two letters of recommendation** (in Chinese or English).

Please submit at least two letters of recommendation written by your professor or advisor.

※If you upload your required documents online, please check the department information if the department you apply need the offline recommendation letters.

(11) **Academic thesis or relevant publications** (only for Ph.D. program applicants).

Please submit a copy of your thesis completed for Master's degree. You are also required to submit an abstract of your thesis which is written either in English or in Chinese, a finished reprint of your published thesis, and a copy of the certificate of the published paper. If you did not complete a thesis, you may submit other relevant academic publications or documentation that would support the obtainment of your Master's degree.

(12) **Additional required materials for departments/graduate institutes** (if applicable, please refer to p.33-44).

Please note that there are certain departments/graduate institutes which require the applicants to submit additional documents or to take additional oral or written exams. You will be notified of any additional exams by those departments/graduate institutes to complete your application.

(13) **Other supplementary documents**

Documents in support of your application, e.g. English or Chinese language proficiency test results, certificates or honors received.

IV. Admission Announcement

1. Application Results

The application results will be available one month after the application documents are processed. Applicants can log onto online application system to check the personal application results during the designated period of time.

2. Mailing Letters of Admission Notification

After the announcement of application results, we will notice the applicants by email and mail out the official notification of admission by post.

V. Enrollment and Registration

1. International students who receive the notification of admission issued by THU are required to submit the “**Letter of Acceptance of Admission for International Students**” to the Office of International Education and Programs (OIEP) by the appointed deadline indicated in the notification of admission to arrange the dormitory application and the airport pick-up services. Failure to reply the letter will result in cancellation of students' admission and other related services by THU and no objection will be accepted.

2. International students who have submitted the “Letter of Acceptance of Admission for International Students” should proceed their registration with THU on the designated date indicated in their notification of admission. They are also required to submit the documents listed below at the time of their registration. Those who fail to submit these required documents will not be allowed to complete their registration with THU as new students. Documents required for completing registration:

- (1) **Passport:** Applicants need to submit a photocopy of the first page of their passport and a photocopy of the page that has their R.O.C. entry visa. The original passport will be returned to the applicants after being verified upon registration.
- (2) **Academic credentials** (an original authenticated document, by a Taiwan overseas representative office or other relevant offices located in the country of the academic institution which issued the academic credentials, are required. If the academic credentials were issued by a Taiwanese education institution, then there is no need to be authenticated by a Taiwan overseas representative office).
- ① Applicants admitted to an undergraduate program:
- Freshman: high school diploma.
 - Transfer: certificate of attendance, transfer certificate or leave-from-studies certificate, or college graduation diploma.
- ② Applicants admitted to a Master's program: Bachelor's degree certificate.
- ③ Applicants admitted to a Ph.D.'s program: Master's degree certificate.
- ❖ If the applicant's graduation certificate/diploma is in a language other than Chinese or English, a notarized document of the translation of the certificate/diploma in English or Chinese is also required.
- (3) **Official transcripts** for all academic years (an original authenticated document, by a Taiwan overseas representative office or other relevant offices located in the country of the academic institution which issued the transcript, are required. If the transcripts were issued by a Taiwanese education institution, then there is no need to be authenticated by a Taiwan overseas representative office).
- ① Applicants admitted to an undergraduate program:
- Freshman: high school transcripts.
 - Transfer: transcripts for all semesters completed at all colleges/universities attend.
- ② Applicants admitted to a Master's program: Bachelor's degree transcripts.
- ③ Applicants admitted to a Ph.D.'s program: Master's degree transcripts.
- ❖ If the applicant's transcripts are in a language other than Chinese or English, a notarized document of the translation of the transcripts in English or Chinese is also required.

- Academic credentials from Mainland China: "The Regulations Governing the Accreditation of Schools in Mainland China" shall apply.
- Academic credentials from Hong Kong or Macao: "Academic Credential Verification and Accreditation Methods adopted in Hong Kong and Macao" shall apply.
- Academic credentials from other areas:
 - Academic credentials earned at overseas Taiwan schools or Taiwan schools in Mainland China shall be regarded as the same as those at domestic schools with equivalent levels.
 - Academic credentials referred in the preceding 2 Items shall be subject to the "Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Credentials for Institutions of Higher Education". However, academic credentials earned from schools or branches established in Mainland China by foreign schools shall require public notarization in Mainland China and be verified and examined by an institute established or appointed by, or through a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan.

Remark:

You may contact an overseas embassy, consulate, or mission abroad of R.O.C. in your home country regarding the authentication of your graduation certificate, transcripts, and other pertinent documents. If there is no overseas representative office of R.O.C. available in your home country, you may contact the closest overseas representative office of R.O.C. located in the neighboring region or country. For a list of embassies or overseas representative offices of R.O.C. (Taiwan), please refer to the website of Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) (<http://www.taiwanembassy.org/>).

- (4) An official proof of the student's medical and accidental insurance policy issued outside the R.O.C. valid for at least 6 months from the date of the student's entry to R.O.C. is required. Such student insurance policy is required to be authenticated by an overseas R.O.C. representative office. For international students who have already insured by R.O.C. National Health Insurance, they must provide a proof of their R.O.C. National Health insurance (such as their R.O.C. National Health insurance ID card). If there is any questions

regarding the required health insurance documents, please contact the Office of International Education and Programs (OIEP) (Tel: +886-4-23590121 ext. 28509; e-mail: isas@thu.edu.tw).

3. Credit Transfer

Transfer credit will be implemented in accordance with the regulations of credit transfer administered by THU. The credits earned from previous college or university courses can be transferred after completing registration and submitting a written application which is approved by the department and the Office of Academic Affairs. Applying for credit transfer can

be done one time only at the designated time during the current semester of the current academic year. Any late applications that are submitted passing the designated time will not be accepted. International students who apply for credit transfer are required to submit their previous transcripts which must be authenticated by a Taiwan overseas representative office. Every department withholds the right to determine whether or not to approve the credit transfer applications submitted by international student applicants. VI. Other Related Information

1. Applicants who apply for admission to THU should agree to authorize THU that all of the information submitted with their applications (including personal information and documents, such as transcripts) will be used by THU for processing their admission applications and registration as well as by the programs/departments to which they intended to apply for relevant research applications. The rest of information submitted by applicants regarding their applications for admission is to be handled pursuant to “Personal Information Protection Act”.
2. **The admission notification issued by THU does not guarantee the applicant’s acquisition of an R.O.C. visa, which will be processed and issued by an overseas embassy, consulate, or mission abroad of the R.O.C. as authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.**
3. In the event when the university later discovers that any international students who have admitted to THU present qualification discrepancies resulting from documents submitted for their applications had been forged, altered, fabricated, or were fraudulent, inaccurate, or lacking legal effect, this will result in the cancellation of their enrollment or expulsion. Also, no academic proof will be provided by the THU. If any condition indicated above is unfolded after international students have graduated from THU, they will be ordered by the university to hand in the certificate of their degree obtained from THU. A public announcement of retracting their graduation status will be made by the university. Such students will also bear legal responsibilities for their own dishonorable conduct.
4. Matters of international students maintaining their admission status, transferring to other schools, changing their major, suspending or discontinuing their schooling, and other matters concerning student status, course work, and life on campus are handled according to “Tunghai University Academic Regulations” and relevant rules. 5. International students may not apply for Extension Programs at universities/colleges designed for returning education students, part-time, in-service courses of Master programs, or other programs, which are restricted to night classes and classes during holidays. International students who have obtained legal resident status of Taiwan, or are enrolled in a program ratified by this Ministry, are exempted from this Article.
6. All the freshmen and transfer students, regardless of department, nationality, and gender, are compulsory to take one year basic labor program with 0 credits. Please visit following website to get more information: <http://labor.thu.edu.tw/>.
7. To obtain the bachelor’s degree from THU, all undergraduates must complete all required courses by their individual departments and also successfully pass the “Foreign Language Proficiency Test” administered either by their department or the university before graduation.

8. The admitted students who graduate from a foreign high school (including those in Hong Kong and Macao) which is considered equivalent to senior high school sophomores in Taiwan are required to complete 12 extra credits for the completion of a bachelor's degree in accordance with "Tunghai University Academic Regulations". Please check periodically the website of THU for the latest regulations pertaining to enrollment applications as needed.
9. If there is any discrepancy within the content of this application brochure between the Chinese version and the translated version in English, the Chinese version shall prevail.
10. This admission for international degree students is processed in accordance with "Tunghai University Academic Regulations" as well as "Tunghai University International Students Entrance Requirements Guidelines".
11. Any application issues which are not addressed in this brochure will be handled according to pertinent rules and regulations of THU and determinations of the admissions committee.

Notification of the Collection, Processing and Use of Personal Information of Examination Candidates by Tunghai University

Pursuant to the “Personal Information Protection Act” (hereafter “the Act”) and in order to ensure the protection of your personal information, privacy and rights, please read in detail the following “Notification of the Collection, Processing and Use of Personal Information of Examination Candidates” formulated by Tunghai University (hereafter “the School”) according to Article 8 and 9 of the Act.

1. Agency (name): Tunghai University
2. Reasons for gathering personal information:
For performing the test service of the School’s admission test, the information (communication) and database management, the statistical research and analysis, and the relevant or required works of the student data management after the enrollment.
3. Way of gathering personal information:
The examination candidates’ personal information obtained via the personal delivery, the mail delivery, the fax or online registration.
4. Types of personal information gathered:
Include name, ID or ARC or Passport number, birthday, photo, gender, educational information, emergency contact person, address, email address, contact information, transfer account, proof of the low-income or the middle-low-income family. The statutory types of personal information ^(Note) are: C001, C002, C003, C011, C021, C023, C033, C034, C038, C051, C052, C056, C057, C061, C062, C064, C072, C111, C132.
5. Handling and use of personal information:
 - (1) Utilizing period:
The utilizing period is the required duration of completing the aforementioned information gathering apart from the expiration date of the personal information for the tests conducted by the ordinance or the central division authority’s additional regulation.
 - (2) The region within which personal information will be used:
Taiwan (including Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu) or places where handling and use has been approved by the examination candidates.
 - (3) Users of personal information:
The units of the School and the relevant cooperative units of completing the aforementioned information gathering, including the Ministry of Education or other administrative, academic and research institutions.
 - (4) Way of using:
 - a. The required exposure (announcement) based on the public trust of the test service, the academic research and other necessary methods for achieving the aforementioned collection objectives due to the School’s proceeding of the test service, admitting, registering, approval, enrollment and students management, contacting the examination candidates (or parents and guardians).
 - b. The School is allowed to provide the personal or relevant information to the related authority or judiciary by the regulation or the demand of the authority or judiciary by law.
6. The untrue, incorrect and incomplete personal information will cause the failure of registering the test, contacting for emergency, and delivering the grades, and that influence the examination candidates’ rights of testing, follow-up test service and accepting the test service. The examination candidates should confirm all provided personal information to be true and correct. If there is any false or requiring alteration, please submit the relevant documentary identification to the Admissions Section, Office of Academic Affairs of the School for the application of correction.
7. In accordance with the Act, the examination candidates can inquire about the information or request to read it, ask for copies, supplement, correct, ask to cease the gathering, use and handling, and for deletion. The examination candidates can exercise the above rights by submitting a hard copy in writing, by fax and by phone with this request to the School (Please check the Registration Requirements for the contacting information). The request of ceasing the gathering, use and handling and for deletion must not obstruct the School’s duty by law.
